Ministry report: Mission & Outreach- Robin and Maribel	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Our guiding philosophy: Help as much as we can; give parishioners the opportunity to be the “hands and feet of Christ”. Let’s not “turn down” people who are willing to serve and volunteer. • A new leader will be hired as Director of Social Justice Ministries. For now, we will not change the job description and allow status quo on organic nature of the Mission and Outreach Ministries, where parishioners volunteer and self-govern their respective ministries. Once the new leader is hired, they will put their own stamp with some guidance from the PPC. • The PPC can “sponsor” key ministries and determine the appropriate budget allocation. “It’s our Church” subcommittee report- Fr. Dave, Robin	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Jan. 31: Listening and information session. Expected outcomes: listening to feelings, service advocacy- provide support groups • Program: Cheryl Mello, brief intro; Robin, brief summary of crisis; Maurice, moderate group discussions with tables of 6 and two facilitators/table answering 3 questions; break; action items • March 1: Dr. Tom Plant to speak for 1 ½ hours post the Pope’s meeting with the bishops at the end of February • The Diocese of Sacramento will release a list of clergy with credible accusations of abuse in February. All Jesuit provinces have released their lists.
Parish Census- Amy	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • This will be coming soon. Boxes of cards will be distributed during Mass for parishioners to update their information. Some information to be asked- preferred weekend Mass, other languages spoken, cultural identity, e-mail address. <p>Action item: Volunteers will be needed to collect the updated cards or to man the tables</p>
Driving seniors- Amy	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • After further consultation with Diocesan insurance, we concluded that this poses a huge liability and therefore decision is that we will not go this route. Instead, we will encourage carpooling and will put in the bulletin.
Church security during Mass- Amy	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Amy sent a note to John Gerges, FBI, and to someone at the Diocese of Sacramento requesting a simple training for identified/select group of parishioners on how to manage disruption during Mass and have them be available in all Masses (like flight marshals)
Hospitality- Christian	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Met with Alan Nissila; putting together hospitality ministry guidelines and job description. Focused on 5 different areas within the Church. Will have uniforms so they’re easily recognizable. Will use schedule sign-ups just like Eucharistic Ministers.
Future business	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • March 6: we will be in the new parish building • Ministry Fair or rolling ministry fair (individual ministries on weekends) • March 9: School Gala- biggest fundraiser for the school • April 6-7: Pastoral Council Election for a member-at-large
